



# REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT AND PROTECTION PROGRAMME FOR NORTH AFRICA

## PHASE VI - KEY RESULTS UP TO DEC 2023



### NIGER

The project responds to the multi-sectorial needs of asylum seekers and refugees hosted in two transit houses managed by COOPI and those in need of a MHPSS assistance from the humanitarian centre managed by UNHCR. In addition, the services are partly offered for the the host community, in order to reduce the risks of conflict and to promote a solid and beneficial integration between local population and refugees.

In the first semester of 2023, 164 asylum seekers and refugees were hosted and received three daily meals in COOPI's transit houses. 390 individuals had access to individual counselling sessions and 71 individuals including refugees and members of the hosting community were referred for a specialized medical assistance.

768 people were enrolled in awareness-raising sessions, educational talks, group discussions and psycho-education sessions.

298 beneficiaries took part in recreational activities designed to improve mental well-being.

Eight children have been enrolled in preschool education program, and 62 adults have been attending French language classes.
