EGYPT - KEY RESULTS UP TO MARCH 2024

Following the start of hostilities in Sudan, UNHCR Egypt faced a surge in new arrivals approaching to seek registration and obtain UNHCR documentation. As a direct result, UNHCR registered and provided government recognized UNHCR documentation to 299,654 refugees and asylum seekers as well as continuous registration to 129,395 asylum seekers and refugees. Despite the Refugee Status Determination (RSD) Unit seconded multiple staff to the Registration Unit, UNHCR was able to surpass the target and finalized 15,607 individual RSD decisions. Moreover, UNHCR carried out capacity building for 232 government officials from the Ministries of Foreign Affairs (MoFA), Justice (MoJ), Interior (MoI), as well as the Diplomatic Corps and the National Council of Human Rights. Furthermore, UNHCR carried out specialized sessions to capacitate government actors on the border with regards to refugee law and international standard and sponsored 7 government officials to attend trainings facilitated by the IHL in Sanremo.

IOM Egypt has achieved the following accomplishments: organization of a pivotal roundtable on the provision of protection services to migrants in Egypt involving representatives from West and Central African countries and relevant national bodies; finalization and submission of a Detailed concept note and recommendations for the National Councils to enhance the data collection of victims of trafficking (VoTs) cases; Mapping of the operational and organizational capacity of the Community-Based Organizations (CBOs) and Delivery of essential items such as desks, chairs, stationery, toys etc to a CBO which is receive a high number of Sudanese migrants ; Design of a guidebook for community leaders for migrant’s rights advocacy.

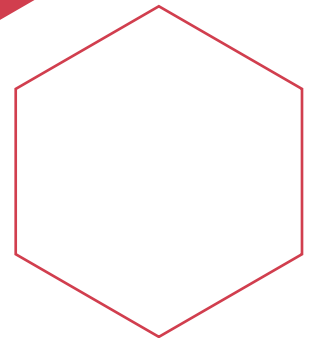

Save the Children Case Management offered services to 401 Unaccompanied and Separated Children, including individual and group mentorship session. A total of 193 UNASC received MHPSS services and 173 UNASC received Emergency Cash. SCI Education team assisted two Community Learning Centers in the delivery of quality Accelerated Learning Programs (ALP), Language Classes, Catch-Up Clubs (CUC). 214 students joined the three learning programs and SCI team also distributed to them 184 education kits. The SCI Youth and Adolescents team conducted an art-focused workshop attended by 54 youth, which was followed by a community awareness event that was attended by another 61. The team also supported four youth-led initiatives with 40 youth from different nationalities.
