10.001 refugees and asylum seekers

808 unaccompanied minors

Till June 2024, 6,794 new individuals were registered (new and continuous registrations) by UNHCR. Among them 745 children were registered and provided with documentation. 3,207 RSD individual decisions were adjudicated, and 225 government officials were trained.

CAPACITY BUILDING

225 national actors and 22 local stakeholders trained

Several preparatory meetings with the key national partners, such as the MASEF and the Direction of the Centres for the Protection and Social Inclusion of the Child (CPISE in French) were organized by IOM. The dissemination of the National Referral Mechanism (NRM) and the creation of the Counter Trafficking (CT) units at the CPISE centres were discussed. Since the start of project, 2 local NGOs that will collaborate closely with the CPISE and the Direction of Childhood to consolidate the foster families' system established in 2022 were selected and 22 families officially validated. A photo contest and an event under the topic of gender-based violence and working conditions of women working as house assistants were also organized.
