10.100 refugees and asylum seekers

805 migrants

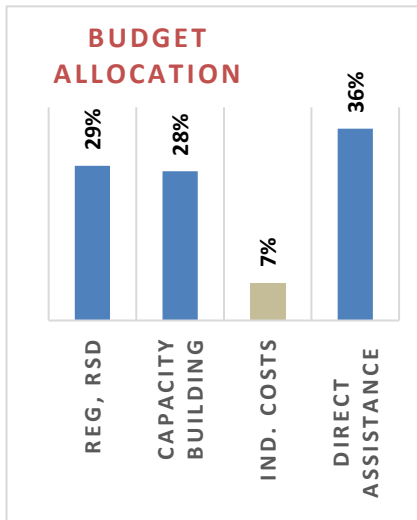
Till June 2024, 3,502 asylum seekers were outreached by the UNHCR partner Moroccan Organisation for Human Rights (OMDH) from Eastern and Northern regions of the country (Oujda, Nador and Tangier) and referred to UNHCR in Rabat for subsequent registration and refugee status determination; 5,647 new asylum seekers were registered; 951 RSD individual decisions were adjudicated; 927 individuals were trained by UNHCR and its partners.

CAPACITY BUILDING

992 national actors trained



Maintaining fair and efficient registration procedures and give access to durable solution to persons in need of international protection timely remains UNHCR's priority.



IOM Morocco organized 2 National Steering Committees (Comités de pilotage du projet) with relevant local authorities and partners. The main CSOs working on migrants' protection were identified and agreements were signed for the provision of humanitarian and legal assistance (805 migrants so far assisted).

In total, 65 representatives of key actors participated to a training on migration governance and protection of vulnerable migrants. A meeting was held with the Ministry of Justice to assess national priorities in terms of capacity building on migration laws. Following several meetings held between IOM and the African Migration Observatory (AMO), the project activities were redefined and aligned with the AMO's current needs. The Terms of Reference (ToRs) were drawn up and shared with stakeholders for validation and for the recruitment of the expert.
